



FCA Huddle Philosophy **A Practical Tool to Aid Your Huddle**

What FCA “IS”

- A Presenting Ministry – reaching out to our teammates and classmates on campus with the message that Jesus Christ loves them and has a plan for their life - not just a “Christian gathering,” but a place for Christians to bring their friends.

What FCA “is NOT”

- Youth group, bible club, church—but “IS” a bridge to the church.

Starting Up

- Build a leadership “Dream Team” – students, coach (s), parents, and youth pastors.
- Pray – include God in the planning.
- Equip students and coaches to present Christ.

How to become an “A+” Huddle?

1. Preparation

- a. Leadership Team – plan ahead (meet on a different day than the Huddle).
- b. Advertise – use many methods of getting the word out: Social Media, mass text, campus announcements, posters, personal invite teams.

2. Play /Create a Fun Environment (especially for non-Christians).

- a. Fun/Games–do crazy stuff that attracts your friends. This keeps people interested & coming back...Humor assists evangelism and gets people to listen.
- b. Food & drinks–pizza, fruit, etc.

3. Prayer (Matt. 7:7-8)

- a. Challenge student leaders to pray for specific classmates/teammates on their campus.
- b. Prayer Groups of parents, church leaders

4. Presentation

- a. Communicate—share God’s Word in a creative, relevant way through students, guest speakers, videos, video clips, social media, etc.
- b. Testimonies—Short, personal stories from students – (Lk. 8:39) “how I came to Christ,” “what is God teaching me,” “why I love and appreciate the Lord.”
- c. Teach—God’s Word accurately to be practical and inspirational.

5. People

- a. Friendliness–be welcoming, high 5’s, sit with new people, greet at the door.
- b. Loving others as Christ Loves you
